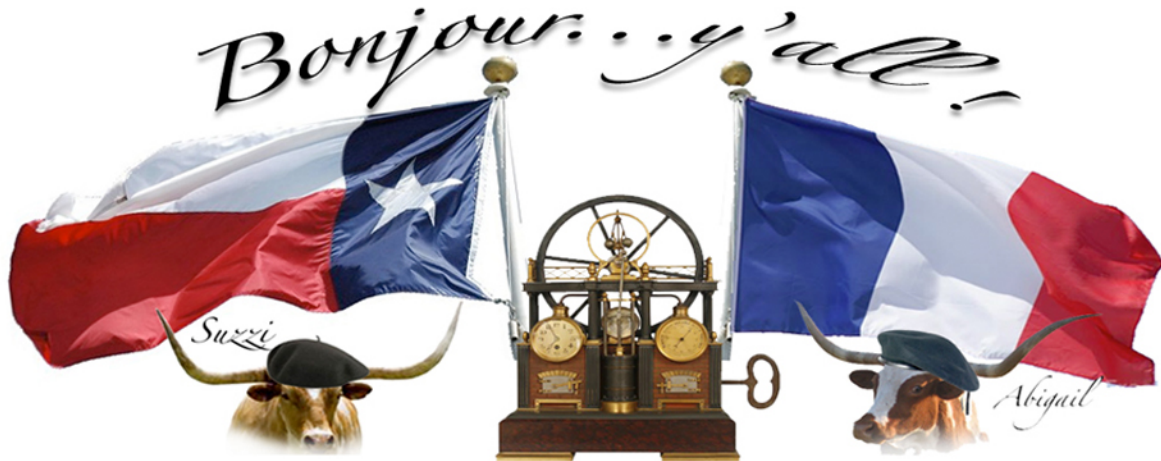

Owners of Seth Thomas Fashion No. 7 Calendar Clocks:

G.J. Pettigrew sold Seth Thomas Fashion Clocks by horse & wagon in the 1870s and 1880s. He lived most of his adult life in various towns in Texas. His sales company was called G J Pettigrew Clock Company. One of the clocks he sold had his company name on the calendar dial. This clock became known as the Fashion No.7 as originated in Gerald Siegel's bulletin article of 1967. I am researching Mr. Pettigrew and the Fashion No. 7.

The study encompasses some specific variations of the Pettigrew clock and will therefore require obtaining data on as many of these clocks as possible.

During this past year I have done extensive genealogical research on G J Pettigrew and have been in contact with some of his descendants. I am continuing to make inquiries to gather information. Some Fashion No. 6 clocks / black dial-gold font, a model that Mr. Pettigrew also sold, have been handed down through the family. I have created a timeline showing locations he lived and other facts. Mr. Pettigrew was married to his first wife for 22 years and had 9 children. Three years after his first wife died he remarried and they had 8 more children.

An article will be submitted for the NAWCC Bulletin or for the digital research archives.
