President's Message

Chapter 124 Members and Friends,

Chapter 124, along with its co-hosts **Southwestern Chapter 15**, **Five State Collectors Chapter 80** and **San Jacinto Chapter 139**, hosted the 2014 Lone Star Regional in Mesquite, TX March 6-8 at the Mesquite Convention Center. We began early on Thursday with a pre-convention class on "Electrical Clock Repairs," taught by **Mike Dempsey**. Twelve students participated, and learned about some of the basic repairs on clocks that are starting to show up on repair benches these days. Sometimes, a simple rebuilding of the motor can add years to the life of these collectible clocks. By 10 am, General Chair **Mike Granderson**, Auction Chair **BruceWooldridge**, and **Joe** and **Mark Richards** had arrived with a U-Haul truck full of clocks for the two evening auctions. And concurrently, **John Hubby, John Evans, Chris Grimm, Claude Leis, Hugh Slough, Tommy Slough, William Slough** and **Fred Tischler** were beginning the process of setting up the "Twist & Turn" exhibit.

The advance work of **Kelsey Downum** and **Evelyn Slough** was evident, when unloading and preregistration volunteers arrived to hand out packets and help table holders unload their goods. Everything ran like clockwork (pun intended), resulting in one of the smoothest set up days in history.

Thursday evening, registrants were treated to a reception with chicken quesadillas with tomatillo salsa, veggie platters, and chips, salsa and queso to get them ready for the first auction. Licensed auctioneer **Jim Sargent** presided, and kept things moving, as we auctioned off more than seventy clocks, tools and horological books.

Friday, the Mart opened with 293 of the available 300 tables sold. The exhibit, "Twist & Turn: The Evolution of Torsion Pendulum Clocks," opened with more than 130 examples from America, Germany, France and Switzerland – and from 1842 to the present day. John Hubby did a magnificent job of curating the display, and arranging the clocks in chronological order. Educationals on Friday included: "Collecting Anniversary Clocks" by John Hubby (and a meeting of the International 400 Day Clock Chapter 168); "The History and Development of the Accutron Watch" by Mike Dempsey; and "Designing a Torsion Pendulum Clock – and Other Clock Design Considerations" by Richard Cox. A walk-through of the exhibit, led by John Hubby, was also well-attended. Silent Auction Chair Sam Creech kept things moving in the Mart by holding several silent auctions throughout the day.

Friday evening, a ticketed banquet was held with 95 in attendance, organized by Hospitality Chair **Pam Tischler**. Guests dined on Green Goddess Salad, Filet Mignon, Garlic Mashed Potatoes, Green Beans Almondine, and finished off with a choice of Apple Strudel or Opera Cake. President **John Acker** presided over the meeting, thanking all of the volunteers for their hard work in making the Regional such a success. Awards Committee Chair **Pam Tischler** presented the Chapter's David Tips Volunteer of the Year Award to **Mark Vozar**. Mark has been an active member of the Chapter for many years, serving on the Board and continuing to teach classes for the Chapter throughout the year. He is also responsible for the development of our Open Bench Workshop program. **Mike Dempsey**, our NAWCC National Representative for the Regional, gave a report on some of the things National is doing to stabilize membership, and talked about the endowment campaign to help put NAWCC on solid financial footing. Mike then announced the recipients of NAWCC Certificates of Appreciation. **Bella Grimm** helped to draw for Door Prizes provided by **Pam & Fred Tischler**; our co-host Chapters: **Southwestern Chapter 15, Five State Collectors Chapter 80 and San Jacinto Chapter 139**; and an anonymous donor. The evening was capped off by another auction.

Chapter 124 expanded its Public Day this year to included four hours on Friday and four hours on Saturday, resulting in approximately 100 public attendees, bringing our total attendance to somewhere around 670! Publicity Chair **E.K. Wilson** worked tirelessly to promote this through the local media, antique stores and word of mouth. Also, on Saturday, an educational entitled "Toys of the Sultans: European and Ottoman Technology" was given by **Nick Lerescu**, as part of the meeting of the Educational Travel Chapter 179. And, to entice our younger set into the field of horology, **Cathy Slough** presided over the Children's Table in the Mart, offering games, coloring sheets and other activities for young people.

Additional thanks go to Pre-Registration Chair **Gene Meysenburg**, Registration Chair **Clinton Kleen**, Finance Chair **John Erickson**, Mart Chair **Dee Koch**, Program Chair **Tim Henz**, Door Prize Chair **Gary Rowland**, Graphic Artist **Peter Crum** and Webmaster **Ronnie Mathis**.
