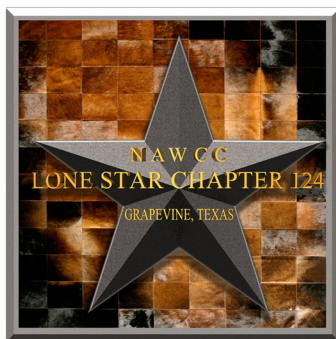

If you are wondering why you are receiving our Newsletter, it is because we are in hopes those of you in the five-state area will plan to attend. Our Regional has the largest Mart in Texas, as well as in the five-state area, with approximately 300 plus tables and is one of the best! Mike Granderson is the Convention Chair with Bruce Wooldridge as the Co-Convention Chair.

The day prior to the Regional on Thursday, March 1st, Mike Dempsey will be teaching a course on his "Top 25 Tips for Clock Repair." This class will showcase some of the best repair tips, ideas and shortcuts that he has put together over 30 years of clock repair. It will include how to make specialty parts, making fixtures and tooling for your lathe and bushing machines, plus how to make a simple gear cutter and repair simple parts. The class will have a power point discussion, and then a demonstration on how these things are made.
